There is immediate access to fishing and boating waters of San Pablo Bay,

Lots of a minimum 10,000 square feet extend well into the water, to protect docking rights for all time, according to Robert Lane, resident project manager.

Lagoons are exceptionally wide — 600 to 3500 feet — and deep, 6 feet dockside at low tide.

A new series of 40 waterfront homes are available on Caribe Isle. Many have double-door entires and are built around protected interior garden courts.

Each home is outfitted with a 30-foot floating dock, hardware and cedar deck.

Quiet waters of Bel Marin Lagoons welcome small boat owners, just as deep-water channel invites salt water sailors.

Youngsters racing El Toro boats find excitement in the lagoon; the wide waterways mean added fun for water-skiing and swimming.

Older sailors can head out into San Pablo Bay — or do some "slip sailing" at the Bel-Marin Yacht Club.

For life's other necessities — regional shopping center, schools, churches are close by — and of course, The City.

The climate permits doing all the things the year 'round in true California style.
